Three inter connected solid granite bowl transition the Church's upper entry level and the lower congregational level. The vertical middle font is used for infant baptisms. The lower font pool is for adult semi-immersion baptisms. Water moves from font pool to font pool creating a soothing meditative background sound.

Your Water Structures representative can help decide if a stone clad or solid stone baptismal font is right for you.

Solid stone baptismal fonts have some natural limitations. Solid stone fonts are much heavier than stone clad fonts; they take longer to design and build; installations are more complex and limiting; and the look of a carved stone font is "imperfect" compared to the standard custom font shells manufactured by Water Structures LLC. All these restrictions add to the cost of a solid stone baptismal font, which usually is more than a stone clad font. The look of a solid stone font is hard to duplicate. Concerns about the extra time and money needed to make and install a solid stone font are likely to disappear when one views the stunning font for the first time.
